General Notice

The City of Nahunta, Georgia (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

Sewerage System Improvements
May 2022 (Revised October 2022)
Project Number 182226

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the Nahunta City Hall located at 9911 Main Street North, Nahunta, Georgia 31553, until 1:00 p.m. local time on Thursday, December 8, 2022 local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

Division One – Additions to Water Pollution Control Plant: Additions to the water pollution control plant to include construction of a screen and grit structure, a treatment plant complete with two trains of aeration basins, clarifiers and digesters, blowers, tertiary filters, ultraviolet disinfection system, a plant pump station, effluent pump station, sludge dewatering containers, control building, and blower building, all complete with appurtenances.

Division Two – Effluent Force Main: Furnishing and installing approximately 7,700 linear feet of 8-inch effluent force main, all complete with appurtenances.

Division Three – Modifications to Pump Stations: Modifications to the pump stations, all complete with appurtenances

Division Four – Sewerage System Rehabilitation: Rehabilitation of the sewerage system including cleaning and televising and cured-in-place lining of approximately 4,000 linear feet of existing 8-inch and larger gravity sewer lines, all complete with appurtenances. Work also includes post-televising, point repairs, pavement repair, service connection repair, manhole construction and rehabilitation, bypass pumping and appurtenances.

Bids are requested for the following Contract: City of Nahunta, Georgia, Sewerage System Improvements, May 2022, Project Number 182226.

The Project has an expected duration of construction of 420 consecutive calendar days for substantial completion and 450 consecutive calendar days for final completion for Division One, 180 consecutive calendar days for substantial completion and 210 consecutive calendar days for final completion for Division Two, and 120 consecutive calendar days for substantial completion and 150 consecutive calendar days for final completion for Division Three.

Obtaining the Bidding Documents

Prospective Bidders may obtain or examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and may obtain copies of the Bidding

Documents from the Issuing Office as described below. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

Printed copies of the Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office during the hours indicated above, upon payment of a deposit of \$625.00 for the drawings and specifications for all four Divisions. Divisions Two and Three only drawings and specifications may be purchased for a deposit of \$300.00. Division Four only drawing and specifications may be purchased for a deposit of \$200.00. An additional set of reduced drawings for all divisions is available for \$450.00. Bidders who return full sets of the Bidding Documents in good condition (suitable for re-use) within 30 days after receipt of Bids will receive a one-half (½) refund. Non-Bidders, and Bidders who obtain more than one set of the Bidding Documents, will receive a refund one-half (½) refund for documents returned in good condition (suitable for re-use) within the time limit indicated above. Make deposit checks for Bidding Documents payable to Turnipseed Engineers. The soils report may be purchased for \$30.00

Bidding Documents may be purchased from the Issuing Office during the hours indicated above. Cost includes regular shipping charges. Upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment, printed Bidding Documents will be sent via regular delivery service. The shipping charge amount will depend on the shipping method chosen.
